As per the Regulations notified by the Council vide F. No. F.No. 37-3/Legal/2004 dated 14th Sept 2006 and norms, standards, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time and based on the recommendations of the Expert Confinittee and EC Sub Committee, I am another to convey the approval of the Council to Shri Sai Rathan Educational (SRES), 3-14-7, srinivaspuram Ramanthaouram, Hyderabad – 500 013 for establishment of new PGDM Institution in the name and style of Rathan Global Business School (RGBS), Ravelly Grampanchayat, Toopran Mandal, Medak Dist. Hyderabad for conduct of the following courses and intake

\*Note: - This Letter of Approval (LOA) shall be valid for two years from the date of issue of letter of approval for fulfilling State Government requirements of admission.

The approval is valid for two years from the date of issue of this letter to Rathan Global Business School (RGBS), Ravelly Grampanchayat, Toopran Mandal, Medak Dist. Hyderabad shall obtain necessary affiliation/permission from the concerned affiliating University as per the prescribed schedule of the University/ Admission Authority etc. The Applicant Society/Trust/Institution shall send information about commencement of the above courses to AICTE. Incase the Institution could not commence the above mentioned courses for whatsoever reasons during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter, the approval becomes invalid and the applicant society/trust shall have to make fresh application to AICTE for grant of fresh approval.

The approval is further subject to fulfillment of following conditions.

- 1. That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and building and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per Council's norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
  - (a) That the admissions shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE
    - That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time
    - (c) That the admissions to the courses shall be made only after the affiliating University /State Board has given permission to start the course
    - (d) That the Institution shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new course (s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council
    - (e) That the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances shall make no excess admissions
    - (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE

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- (g) That the Institution shall not allow conduct of any unapproved course whether technical or non technical in the premises of AICTE approved institution/campus and /or in the name of the Institution without prior permission from AICTE.
- 3. That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.
- 4. That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/guardians of students in any form.
- 5. That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or person authorized by it.
- 6. That the Director/Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are paid as per the norms prescribed by the Council for time to time.
- (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.
  - (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be housed in the Institution Web-Site. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
  - (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a web-site providing the prescribed information. The website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
  - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time.
  - (e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of AICTE approval.
- 8. That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliating University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 9. That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
- 10. That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Printers, legal software etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.
- 11. That a Refundable Performance Guarantee Fee (RPGF) shall be deposited with AICTE, New Delhi for an amount and period prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 12 AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year any time for verifying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.

That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of mis-representation, violation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc.. 13

That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-

14 That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time

That the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. (C) 656/1998. Incase of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by 15 16 the institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action including withdrawal of approval

That the institution shall provide the following facilities for the physically challenged persons: 17

Class rooms, toilets and hostels to be made accessible to wheel chair users

Resources room for visually impaired students (b)

Accessible Library (c)

Counseling Centre for disabled students (d)

Facility of Sign Language Interpreter

All students needing assistive devices to be provided such devices

That in the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the 18. Institution / University to the student/candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School/Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students (See Public Notice AICTE/DPG/03(01)/2008)

In the event of non-compliance by the Rathan Global Business School (RGBS), Ravelly Grampanchayat, Toopran Mandal, Medak Dist. Hyderabad with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions prescribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval or recognition, without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would solely be that of the concerned Rathan Global Business School (RGBS), Ravelly Grampanchayat, Toopran Mandal, Medak Dist.

Issuance of Letter of Intent for establishment of new PGDM Institution in the name and style of Rathan Global Business School (RGBS), Ravelly Grampanchayat, Toopran Mandal, Medak Dist, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh for the block period 2009-2012- Reg..

Sir / Madam,

This is with reference to your application submitted to the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for establishment of new technical institution.

LETTER OF INTENT

The proposal was processed as per the procedures, guidelines, policies and norms and standards of AICTE and I am directed to convey the decision of the Council to issue the Letter of Intent (LOI) for the establishment of new PGDM institution in the name and style Rathan Global Business School (RGBS), Ravelly Grampanchayat, Toopran Mandal, Medak Dist, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh. This Letter of Intent will be valid for three years from the date of issue.

To facilitate further processing of the proposal for grant of approval, you are now required to furnish the following documents in one lot at the respective Regional Office, AICTE, and your proposal would be processed subsequently.

A registered undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper of not less than Rs. 100/-, stating that the Institution shall abide by all the Regulations, Guidelines, Norms and Standards of the Council as applicable from time to time.

A Joint Fixed Deposit created for a period of 8 years in the name of the President/Chairman of the Applicant Society/Trust and the concerned Regional Officer of AICTE for an amount as applicable to the category of the institutions indicated below (Government and Government Aided Institutions and Government University are exempted):

Architecture/Applied Arts & Crafts (Degree)/ HMCT/ MBA/MCA/PGDM/Pharmacy	Rs. 15.00 Lakhs

- The original Joint Fixed Deposit receipt shall be kept under the custody of the proposed institution. A copy of the Joint Fixed Deposit receipt shall be submitted to the concerned Regional Office of the AICTE along with an affidavit on Nonjudicial stamp paper of prescribed value stating that the Joint Fixed Deposit shall not be encashed or modified without prior consent of AICTE. The Regional Officer AICTE shall also instruct the concerned Bank not to allow any encashed / modification of fixed deposit and grant of loan against the deposit without the prior consent of AICTE.
- The interest accrued on the Fixed Deposit will be credited to the concerned of the institution on yearly basis and shall be utilized for award of scholarships to the students.
- The Joint Fixed Deposit shall be permitted to be enchased on expiry of the term of the Fixed Deposit. However, the term of the fixed deposit could be extended for a further period as may be decided on case-to-case basis and / or forfeited in case of any violation of norms, conditions and requirement and / or non-performance by the institution and / or complaints against the institution.
- A non-refundable visiting fee of Rs. 80,000/- drawn in favour of The Member Secretary, AICTE on any nationalized bank payable at New Delhi.
- The applicant Society / Trust needs to Indicate its readiness for Expert Committee Visit within TWO months from the date of Issue of Letter of Intent (LOI) for further consideration of the case for issue of Letter of Approval (LOA) for the current academic year i.e 2009-2010
- An Expert Committee shall visit within fifteen days from the date of intimation of readiness from the applicant An expert Committee shall be applicant society falls to convey its readiness for Expert Committee Visit within two months from the date of Issue of Letter of Intent (LOI) OR refuses for conduct of Expert Committee visit within months from the date of intimation of readiness, the Council will be constrained to consider the supulated intermediate to consider the proposal for establishment of new institution not for the academic year 2009-2010 but for next year i.e. 2010-2011

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Your proposal will be processed only on fulfillment of the conditions mentioned above.

Subject to the fulfillment of all the conditions mentioned above, an Expert Committee visit shall be arranged by the Council for verification of all the facilities required for establishment of a new institution.

The Visiting Expert Committee will verify the original documents and all the necessary infrastructural facilities required for establishment of a new institution as per norms of the Council as detailed below and also mentioned in the expert committee visit report.

 Original documents related to the land for the proposed institution and the other existing institutions (if any) for verification. Documents (Khasra Plan etc.) to check continuity of land.

Land use certificate for the entire land of the proposed institution.

The site plan for the proposed land in relation to the adjoining built up structures, road etc.

The building plan for the proposed institution clearly mentioning the survey numbers of the land area.

- Whether the land of the proposed Institution has been fully developed with clear demarcations, either by a boundary wall / barbed wire fencing and all weather approach road to the Institution.
- Availability of clear-cut demarcation of the built up space for the proposed institution from the built up space for the existing institution/s (if any in the same land/premises).
- Whether the building is complete in all respects including plastering, internal electrification and effective conduct of classes etc. at least adequate for first year of the programme.

Whether Permanent electrical and potable water connection is obtained.

- Whether all the required furniture and fixtures are in place as per requirements.
- Whether books and Journals, as per Norms and Standards, have been procured, stamped and entered in the Accession Register.

Whether equipment, as per syllabus of first year, has been procured and is ready for use.

- Whether copy of advertisement for recruitment of faculty, composition and proceedings of selection committee meeting are available.
- Whether Director / Principal has been appointed, and faculty identified and their consent letter for joining the institution obtained.
- Whether adequate operational funds as per AICTE norms are available in the form FDR/ Savings Account/Current
  Account in the name of the Society/Trust for all the institutions run by the Trust.

The Expert Committee while examining the infrastructure / facilities will verify as to whether the development is in consonance with the proposal in the DPR and shall get a complete video CD of all the facilities.

The Expert Committee report shall be processed as per the revised Approval Process and the final decision for grant of approval or otherwise shall be communicated to all the concerned by AICTE, subsequently.

The applicant Trust/Society is hereby informed that issuance of LOI by AICTE does not entitle it automatic grant of Approval. The proposed institution cannot commence any educational activity and admit students based on LOI.
